### **Beaver Area Memorial Library**

**Independent Reading** for Grades 1 to 6 begins June 1. ***Read 4 Library Books*** at your reading level before Fri. July 31, 2009. (Max. of 4 books by one author—Keene, Stine, Snicket, etc.)

**Read to Me** for Preschool through Kindergarten (Child not reading on own.) begins June 1.

Read 20 Library books by July 31.

**Story Hours for Ages 3 to 6** begins Tuesday, June 23 at 1:30 PM through July 21 **OR** Wed., June 24 at 10:30 AM **OR** 1:30 PM through July 22. Sign-ups begin Monday, June 1.
